## Program Description

### Overview

The three week summer school “Engineering and Management across Cultures” provides an introduction to key TUM research areas : Geodesy and Sustainable Management of Natural Resources. You can choose one of the specialized topics of the Summer School. A particular highlight of the program is an intensive seminar of several days which takes place at the fundamental station Wetzell or at Straubing Center of Science according to your focus.

### Target Group and Requirements

The program is open to students of geodesy, environmental engineering and general engineering or related majors. Students should have completed their first year of Bachelor’s studies.

### Workshops

- A series of interdisciplinary technical workshops in the area of geodesy and sustainable management of natural resources
- An intensive seminar of several days at the Fundamental Station Wetzell focusing on satellite geodesy or at Straubing Center of Science focusing on renewable resources
- International project management and all-day intercultural training

## German Language Course
